

## Trem y Bwlch

The three new cottages of Trem y Bwlch were constructed in 2010 on a field lying between the two chapels in Pentredŵr. The field had belonged to Pentredŵr Farm (Maesyrychen) for over two hundred years, but was purchased by Cymdeithas Tai Clwyd in order to build a small number of affordable homes for social housing, as part of a rural development project costing nearly two million pounds.



New affordable housing is critical for villages such as Pentredŵr, allowing younger families to remain in the area instead of having to move away. Following the demolition of Post Office Terrace thirty five years before, the building of these three cottages provided welcome new living space that will help Pentredwr keep its community alive.
